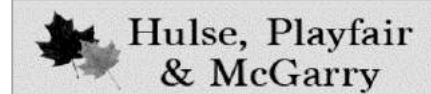

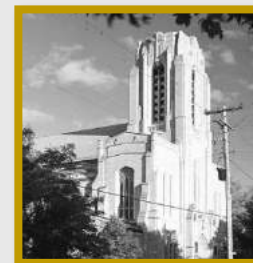

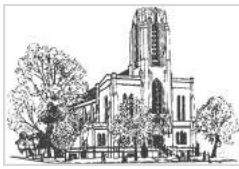
The Power of the Holy Rosary
