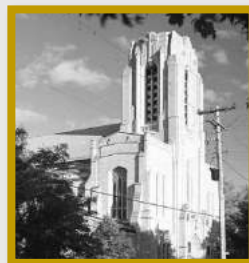

Dear Parishioners of Blessed Sacrament Parish,

I hope you have had a good summer so far!

As Labour Day approaches and classes resume in our
schools, colleges and universities, we are making the
transition from Summer to Fall.

As many of you are aware, Father Galen initiated a
change in Mass times over the summer months,
consolidating the 9:00 am and 11:00 am Masses into
one Mass at 10:00 am. One reason for his decision
was to gather the different Sunday morning
communities together.

The idea was that having the one Mass in the
morning, would make it easier to coordinate the
volunteers within in all the different ministries. Also,
the 10:00 am start would leave time available for any
pre- and post-Mass activities in the parish hall, such
as Coffee Sunday and other types of activities. We
will continue to develop this approach in the
Fall. The Sunday Mass schedule will continue to be
10:00 am and 8:00 pm.

With respect to ministries, we are currently working
on a plan to organize our ministries such that new
volunteers can join each ministry, receive clear
ministry descriptions and have other structures in
place to support their valuable efforts.

With this in mind, we will host a parish "Volunteer
Recruitment Breakfast," or similar event, in either
late 2017 or early 2018 (date to be confirmed). The
medium-term goal is to have everything in place to
permit us to successfully hold such an event each
year, beginning in September 2018.

May you have a blessed Labour Day, and may St.
Joseph the Patron of Workers intercede for you and
your family!
