**A personal letter to our Parish from
Archbishop Prendergast ...**

Dear Parishioners of Blessed Sacrament Parish,

Thank you for the warm reception you have
given Fr. Geoffrey Kerslake since his arrival
August 1st as the Pastor of Blessed Sacrament
Parish. He has kept me informed of the
developments in the parish and has often
remarked on his admiration for the dedicated
volunteers and committed parishioners he has
met during the past three months.

Blessed Sacrament Parish would benefit from
the appointment of a Pastor in residence who
can dedicate his full ministry to serving the
needs of the parish. At the present time, Fr.
Kerslake is dividing his time between two (2)
assignments, which is not the best situation for
the Parish.

Fr. Kerslake, therefore, will be reassigned to
Notre Dame Cathedral at the end of November
where he will reside and assume duties as Vice
Rector in collaboration with the Rector,
Monsignor Daniel Berniquez. He will continue in
his role as Episcopal Vicar for Pastoral Services.

Fr. Timothy Nelligan will be appointed as the
full-time Pastor in residence at Blessed
Sacrament Parish as of December 1st, 2017. Fr.
Nelligan comes to the Archdiocese of Ottawa
after many years of ministry as a Chaplain with
the Canadian Forces. For the past three months
he has been assisting at Notre Dame Cathedral
as Vice Rector. He is looking forward to serving
the Parish Community as his ministry.

Fr. Timothy McCauley is remaining as the part-
time Assistant Pastor. Fr. Kerslake has begun
working with Fr. Nelligan and Fr. McCauley in
making this transition.

Thank you for your support of Fr. Kerslake and
for your assistance as we make this change to
best serve the needs of the Parish Community.

May God bless you and your family and may the
Blessed Sacrament continue to be your solace
and strength.
