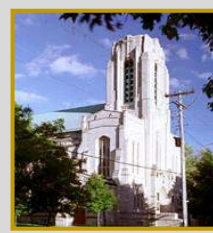

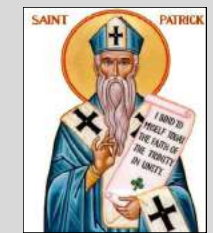

• Chair; Vice-Chair; Secretary; Treasurer; and Voting Members.

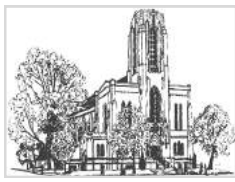
With this in mind, please start considering who you would like to nominate. Forms for Election will be available after the Sunday Masses on Divine Mercy Sunday weekend (April 7/8).
