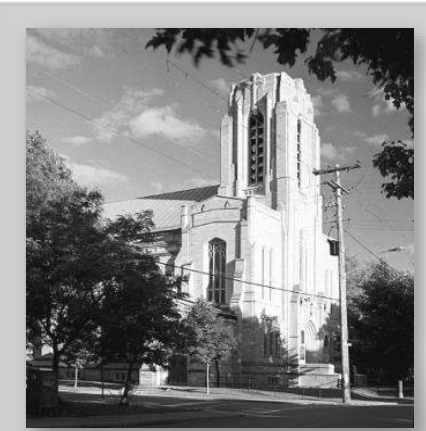

Saint of the Week — St. Anthony Mary Zaccaria
(Feast Day: July 5—Patron Saint of the sick and the poor)

Born in 1502 in Cremona Italy, St. Anthony became a medical doctor at age 22, mainly working in hospitals for the poor. He was ordained a priest at age 26 and laid the foundations of 3 religious congregations, one for men (the Barnabites); one for women (Angelic Sisters of St. Paul); and one for married couples (the Laity of St. Paul). Their aim was to reform the decadent society of their day, beginning with the clergy, religious and lay people. He encouraged such innovations as the collaboration of the laity in the apostolate, frequent Communion, the Forty Hour devotion and the ringing of church bells at 3:00 pm on Fridays. After his death at age 36, a number of cures were attributed to his intercession. 27 years after his death, his body was found to be incorrupt. His mortal remains are now enshrined at the Church of St. Barnabas in Milan, Italy.



St. Pope John Paul II, 2000 — At a time of widespread laxity, St. Anthony Mary Zaccaria revived the faith by fostering an intense life of inner renewal centered on the Crucified One and on the devotion to the Eucharist, the heart of the Church's life. St. Anthony constantly pointed out the goal of holiness, not only to his religious who had set out on the path of spiritual 'reform' or 'renewal', but to all the faithful, whom he reminded of their call to become 'not small ... but great saints'.
