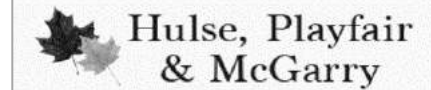

EUTHANASIA/ASSISTED SUICIDE – DID YOU KNOW?

Since Canada legalized euthanasia/assisted suicide in June 2016, **374** people across the country have already died by lethal injection and only 30% of Canadians have access to quality palliative (end of life) care. Despite wording intended to protect doctors and facilities, the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario is forcing health care workers to arrange for the killing of their patients. If your family doctor or surgeon objects to providing a referral, they could be fined, disciplined or even removed from their practice. No other country does this. No other province does this. No foreign jurisdiction in the world that has legalized euthanasia/assisted suicide has forced health care workers or facilities to act against their conscience. 8 provinces in Canada have adopted protocols to protect doctors and institutions, yet Ontario refuses to protect doctors who object to ending the life of their patients.
