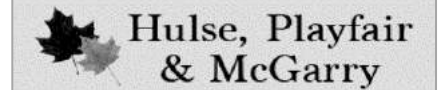

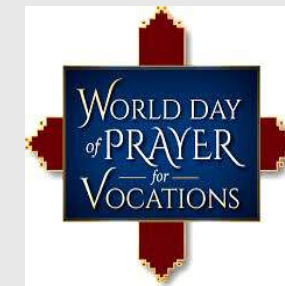

May 7, 2017 — 4th Sunday of Easter



May 13, 2017 marks the 100th anniversary
of the first of the six apparitions of the
Blessed Virgin Mary to three shepherd
children in Fatima, Portugal. In honour of
this centenary, Pope Francis has declared
a Jubilee Year granting the opportunity for
the Catholic faithful to obtain **plenary
indulgences** under the normal conditions:

1) Detachment from sin, confession,
communion, and prayers for the
intentions of the Holy Father;

2) Devotedly participate in prayer,
honouring the Blessed Virgin Mary;

3) Pray the "Our Father", the "Creed" and
invoke Our Lady of Fatima; **AND**

4) Meet ONE of the following conditions:

* **Make a pilgrimage to Fatima,
Portugal during the Jubilee year; or**

* **On the 13th of each month from
May to October (the six days of the
apparitions), visit a Church that is
publically venerating an image of
Our Lady of Fatima; or**

* **For the infirm who are incapable of
a public pilgrimage, on the days of
the apparitions, having had the firm
intention of carrying out the
conditions as soon as you are able,
join "spiritually in the celebrations,
offering with confidence to the
merciful God through Mary, your
prayers and pains, or the sacrifices
of your own life" in front of an
image of Our Lady of Fatima.**

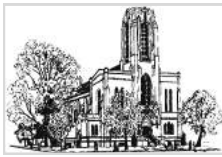
