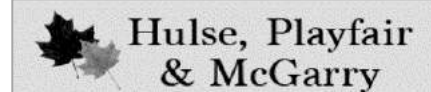

Blessed be Jesus in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar!
Shortly after celebrating Mass on Saturday, August 18, 1996 at St. Mary's in Buenos Aires, Argentina, Fr. Pezet found a discarded host at the back of the church. He placed it in water and put it in the tabernacle. On August 26, Fr. Pezet opened the tabernacle and discovered that the Host had not dissolved but turned into a bloody substance. Cardinal Jorge Bergoglio (Pope Francis!) instructed him to have the Host professionally photographed. For three years the Host remained in the tabernacle with no visible sign of decomposition and the Cardinal decided to have it scientifically analyzed.

On October 5, 1999, a sample was taken and brought to New York to a team of scientists who were not told of the source. A well-known cardiologist and forensic pathologist, Dr. Frederic Zugib, determined "it is a fragment of a human heart muscle found in the wall of the left ventricle close to the valves and is responsible for the contraction of the heart and pumps blood to all parts of the body. The heart muscle is inflamed and contains a large number of white blood cells. As white blood cells require a living organism to survive, their presence indicate the heart was alive when the sample was taken. These white blood cells penetrated the tissue which further indicates that the heart had been under severe stress, as if the owner had been beaten severely about the chest."

DNA testing confirms it is from a human male with an AB positive blood type. Testing also shows there is no sign of preservatives. Further, it is an exact match to another Eucharist miracle from the 8th century in Lanciano, Italy and confirms it came from the same person.
