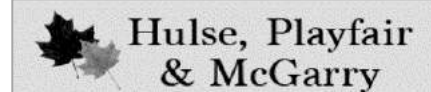

CONSECRATION OF THE ARCHDIOCESE TO THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY ON CANADA DAY:

Archbishop Prendergast will renew the consecration of the Diocese/Archdiocese to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, at a Mass at **10:00 am on Canada Day, July 1 at Notre Dame Cathedral.** All are invited to attend. This consecration is tied to a number of historic events — Canada's 150th; the 170th Anniversary of the Foundation of the Diocese of Bytown-Ottawa on 25 June 1847; the 70th Anniversary of the 1947 Marian Congress marking the centennial of the Archdiocese; and, with prayers for peace, the 100th Anniversary of the Fatima apparitions. Canada was consecrated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary at the Marian Congress in 1947 and was re-consecrated in 1954 for the Marian Year. This will be a renewal of that consecration. On 26 September 2017, the Bishops of Canada, during their Plenary Assembly, will jointly consecrate the country to Mary's Immaculate Heart at Notre Dame Cathedral Ottawa as part of the Golden Jubilee celebrations of the foundation of Development and Peace in Ottawa.

INTER-FAITH APPEAL — Special Collection

"In light of the great suffering in South Sudan, Yemen, northeast Nigeria & Somalia, the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops is making an appeal, together with inter-faith groups, to help address the famine and urgent food shortages facing 20 million people in these areas. The Canadian government will match funds sent in before June 30. **To meet this deadline, Archbishop Prendergast has mandated that a special collection be taken up in all parishes before June 25.** Blessed Sacrament will take up this collection THIS weekend at each Mass following Holy Communion.
