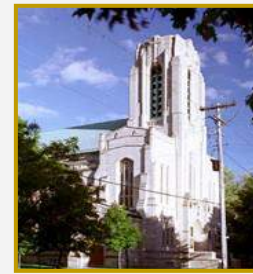

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Happy Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord!

As we gather this weekend to celebrate the Manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles, we are reminded of Christ's great commission to his Apostles after his Resurrection ...
"Go forth proclaiming the Gospel, baptizing in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

In our penitential rite at the beginning of Mass, we say, "Lord Jesus, you came to gather the nations into one, Lord, have mercy." This acknowledgment of what we celebrate at Epiphany, namely that Christ has been revealed to the gentiles, continues to be echoed in our present world.

We, each of us who dare to call ourselves the 'disciples of Christ', are called to be about the work of manifesting Christ to the world. We do this in our daily deeds; what we say, what we do. By virtue of our own Baptism we share in the priestly, prophetic and kingly life of Christ.

Let us call out to all those who have lost their faith or have become lukewarm, especially to families with children who have lost the flame of their own Baptism, that they may re-ignite it in their hearts and in their homes so that the Epiphany of Christ may truly be a manifestation in their lives.
