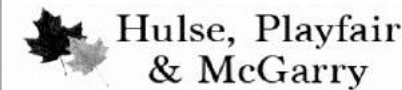

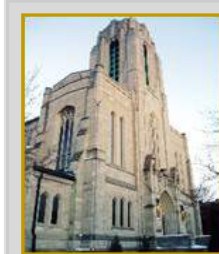

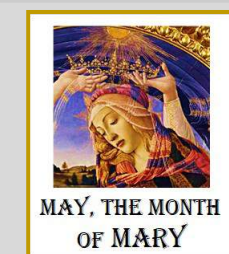

Parish Phrontistry

7th Major Council:
— *The Second Council of Nicaea*

In 787, just over a century after the Third Council of Constantinople, a 7th General Council was necessary in 787 to deal with the heresy of Iconoclasm. The Council was called by the Empress Irene—the widow of the late Emperor Leo IV and mother of the Emperor Constantine IV—to head off the growing unrest with the Eastern Bishops who were spreading the heresy of Iconoclasm fostered by Emperor Leo III. The latter had been fiercely condemned by Pope Hadrian I, as well as his predecessors Popes Gregory II and Pope Gregory III. A great Doctor of the Church, *Saint John Damascene*, had also defended images as a means of reverence. At the core was the growing split and resentment between East and West.

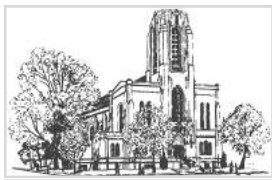
