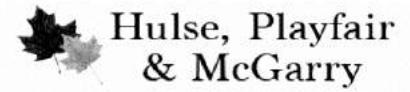

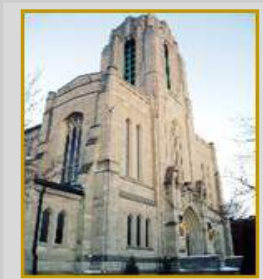

11th Major Council:
— **The Third Lateran Council**
In 1179, Pope Alexander III called the Third Council at the Lateran Basilica because once again a General Council had to be called to undo the damage done by antipopes Victor IV and others. The Council also set that the election of the Roman Pontiff must be by two-thirds of the majority of cardinals voting, establishing the Sacred Conclave as the voting body. The Council condemned the heresies of Albigenses and Waldenses.

The Origins of Trinity Sunday



Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and every shall be, world without end. Amen!

'In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.' 'The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us.' Jn 1:1,14
'The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My Name, will teach you all things.' Jn 14:26
'Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.' Mt 28:19

Pope Gregory IX instituted Trinity Sunday in 828 CE. It was extended to the Universal Church by Pope John XXII (1316-34) and we celebrate it on the Sunday following Pentecost.

The origins of celebrating the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, date back to the Arian heresy of the fourth century. Arius, a presbyter from Alexandria Egypt, believed that Jesus Christ was a created being rather than God. In denying the divinity of Christ, Arius denied that there are Three Persons in God. Arius' chief opponent, **Athanasius**, upheld the orthodox doctrine that there are Three Persons in One God, and the orthodox view prevailed at the First Council of Nicaea in 325 from which we get the **Nicene Creed**. During the Council it is said that, confronted with Arius' blasphemous views, **Saint Nicholas of Myra** marched across the council floor and slapped Arius across the face. By all accounts, Saint Nicholas combined a firm orthodoxy with a gentleness toward those in his flock, and Arius' false teaching threatened the souls of Christians.
