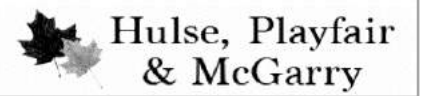

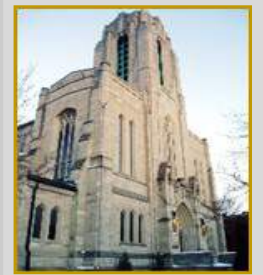

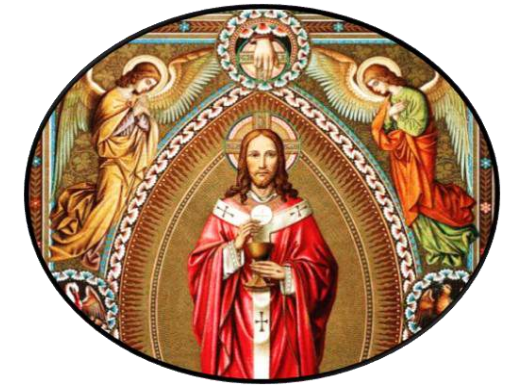

**12th Major Council:**  
— The Fourth Lateran Council

In 1215, Pope Innocent III called the Fourth Lateran Council 36 years after Lateran III had closed. This Council was the most absolute and most impacting of all ecumenical councils to date. Nearly 500 prelates, as well as the Patriarchs of Constantinople and Jerusalem, and close to a thousand abbots including Saint Dominic attended. Here Innocent, trying to recover from the immense sadness three years earlier of the failed Children's Crusade (5th Crusade), successfully regained his power. It marked the pinnacle of papal power in medieval times. It was Innocent who defined *ex cathedra* — from the chair of Peter and who declared in that position that "There is but one Universal Church, outside of which there is no salvation."

The Council officially set in stone the term 'Transubstantiation' for the mystery of the bread and wine conformed into the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ and reformed disciplines of ecclesiastical life, as well as directing all Catholics to partake in the Sacraments of Penance and the Holy Eucharist no less than once a year. The Lateran IV Council also condemned as anathema once more the heresies of Albigensianism, which taught marriage and the sacraments were not needed, and Waldensianism, which taught that the laity could perform the same duties as a priest when said priest was in mortal sin.
