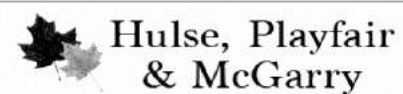

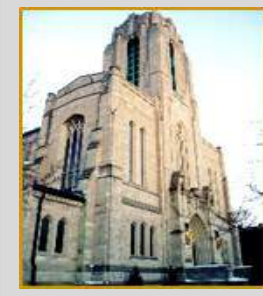

Parish Phrontistery

19th Major Council:
— *The Council of Trent*

The greatest and longest of all the major ecumenical councils was convened by Pope Paul III on December 13, 1545 in the mountain village of Trent in northern Italy. There were 25 major sessions that spanned eighteen years under five popes: Pope Julius III, Marcellus II, Paul IV and Pope Pius IV who closed the last session on December 4, 1563 with Pius IV issuing a Papal Bull on February 7, 1564 confirming all that was declared at Trent. Pope Saint Pius V completed the commission of Trent, reforming the Roman Missal with his *De Defectibus* and *Quo Primum* writing the *Catechism of Trent* based on all the decrees of Trent and also set up a commission to issue a more exact edition of the Latin Vulgate Bible. The Council issued the most dogmatic and reformatory decrees ever, specifically on the Holy Eucharist, the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and the Sacraments plus reinstating traditions always held 'Catholic.' Trent was the ideal Counter-Reformation to the Protestant Reformation where Protestantism was condemned as anathema along with Martin Luther and other reformers who had jolted the Church. Moral discipline was emphasized and reinforced in order that Holy Mother Church regain the respect and authority intended for the Church Christ founded and passed down through His infallible, perennial Magisterium of the Church, preserving the Truths and Traditions of Holy Mother Church in the Sacred Deposit of the Faith.

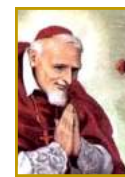

This Weeks Saints ... Pray for us!



ST. IGNATIUS OF LOYOLA — Feast Day: July 31

St. Ignatius was a priest and theologian who, just before the Council of Trent, founded a religious order called the Society of Jesus (Jesuits). St. Ignatius insisted on a high level of academic preparation for the clergy and prior to his death in 1556, the Jesuits operated 74 colleges on 3 continents. Through sound teaching, they were largely responsible for stopping the spread of the Protestant Reformation. St. Ignatius was a gifted Spiritual Director and wrote a celebrated treatise called the *Spiritual Exercises*. These exercises remain invaluable today and are still widely practiced by religious and laity alike. *St. Ignatius, patron Saint of the Society of Jesus, soldiers, educators & education, pray for us!*



ST. ALPHONSUS LIGUORI — Feast Day: August 1

St. Alphonsus, proclaimed a Doctor of the Church by Pope Pius IX, was a child prodigy who received his doctorate in law at age 16 and became one of the leading lawyers in Naples — though he never attended court without first having attended Mass. St. Ignatius was ordained at 29 and at age 34 founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (the Redemptorists) who preached in the slums and fought Jansenism, a heresy that supported a very strict morality — "*Penitents should be treated as souls to be saved rather than as criminals to be punished*". Afflicted with severe rheumatism, he could barely move or raise his chin from his chest. He published nine editions of his *Moral Theology* and many devotional works, including *The Glories of Mary* and *The Way of the Cross*, still used in parishes today during Lent. *St. Alphonsus Liguori, patron Saint of Confessors, pray for us!*



ST. JEAN-BAPTISTE MARIE VIANNEY (CURÉ D'ARS) — Feast Day: August 4

St. Jean Vianney, Patron Saint of Parish Priests, is "a rare example of a pastor acutely aware of his responsibilities ... a sign of courage for those who today experience the grace of being called to the priesthood." — *Saint John Paul II*, 1986.

St. Jean's prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood, let us pray:
"God, please give to Your Church today many more priests after Your own Heart. May they be worthy representatives of Christ the Good Shepherd. May they wholeheartedly devote themselves to prayer and penance; be examples of humility and poverty; shining models of holiness; tireless and powerful preachers of the Word of God; zealous dispensers of Your grace in the sacraments. May their loving devotion to Your Son Jesus in the Eucharist and to Mary His Mother, be the twin fountains of fruitfulness for their ministry. Amen." *St. Jean Vianney, pray for our Priests!*
