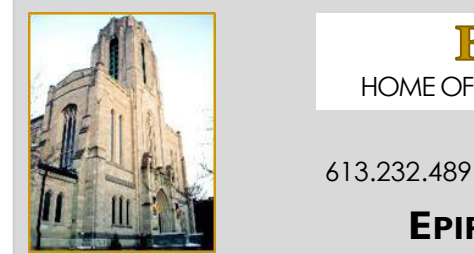

Leader:
"Peace be to this house and to all who dwell here, in the Name of the Lord."
All: Thanks be to God.

Reader:
When Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, in the days of King Herod, behold, Magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying, "Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage." After their audience with the king they set out. And behold, the star that they had seen at its rising preceded them, until it came and stopped over the place where the child was.
They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed for their country by another way.

All: Thanks be to God

Using chalk, write on the outside of your house or inside above the front main entrance, above or next to an entrance (20+19 means the year):
20+Christus+Mansionem+Benedicat+19
or: 20+C+M+B+19

These words mean "May Christ bless this house".
Or you may use the names of the Magi,
20+Caspar+Melchior+Balthazar+19
or their initials: 20+C+M+B+19

Leader:
Lord God of heaven and earth, you revealed Your only begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who live here and all who visit. May we be blessed with health, kindness of heart, gentleness and the keeping of your law. Fill us with the light of Christ, that our love for each other may go out to all. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
