Happy Mother's Day!

Continuing from last weekend's bulletin, the following is the balance of the Decree that Fr. Tim read at all the Sunday Masses on April 27 and 28, 2019 (Part 2 of 2):

DECREE

Extinctive union of the Parish of St. Margaret Mary Alcoque of Ottawa with the Parish of Blessed Sacrament of Ottawa

- 10. The Roman Catholics with a domicile in the territory of the parish subject to this extinctive union will be, as of June 24, 2019, parishioners of Blessed Sacrament parish. Those parishioners living outside the territory will be parishioners of the English parish that includes the territory of their home residence. However, parishioners in either of the mentioned groups may register in any other parish if they so wish.
11. The parish registers for baptisms, confirmation, funerals, marriages, as well as other parish registers will be entrusted to Blessed Sacrament parish, where they will be carefully preserved. Likewise, the marriage files will be kept at Blessed Sacrament Parish; parish financial reports and other information will be forwarded to the Archdiocese of Ottawa for appropriate preservation.
12. With the consent of the pastor of Blessed Sacrament parish and all persons concerned, the temporal goods of St. Margaret Mary parish will be distributed as follows:
a. The moveable liturgical goods will be distributed according to the instructions of the Pastor of St. Margaret Mary working with the Episcopal Vicar for the English sector.
b. The remaining moveable goods and rectory furnishings will be first offered to Blessed Sacrament and what remains of the moveable goods will be distributed by the Archdiocese, with the assistance of the Pastor of St. Margaret Mary. The Archdiocese will retain 5% of the proceeds to compensate its efforts.
c. The Archdiocese will obtain a same use as is market value appraisal of the immovable goods and be guided by the appraisal in its sale of the church building and rectory from the parish to the Archdiocese or from the parish to another entity. After all debts and obligations have been satisfied, the remaining sum will be deposited in the Parish Loan Fund at the Archdiocese for Blessed Sacrament.
13. The last Eucharistic celebration in the church of St. Margaret Mary Alcoque of Ottawa will be Sunday June 23, 2019. This decree will be made public either by a printed notice or by being read in the churches of St. Margaret Mary, Ottawa and Blessed Sacrament the Sunday after its reception and will become effective June 24, 2019. The date of publication of this decree determines, in each parish, the start of the period of hierarchical recourse of ten days according to canon 1734, §2 of the Code of Canon Law.
14. Given at Ottawa, at the Metropolitan Curia, under our sign and seal and the countersign of our Chancellor, on the 23rd day of the month of April in the year of Our Lord two thousand and nineteen.

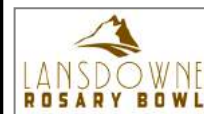
