WHY DOES THE CHURCH ENCOURAGE MASS INTENTIONS?

What does it mean to have a Mass "offered" for someone? First and foremost, we are reminded that from the earliest times of the Church, even in the 1st Century, the tradition of offering Masses for others, particularly the dead, originated. When we face the death of someone, even a person who is not Catholic, to have a Mass offered for the repose of his soul and to offer our prayers are more beneficial and comforting than any other sympathy card or bouquet of flowers. To have a Mass offered on the occasion of a birthday, anniversary or special need is appropriate, beneficial and appreciated. One must never forget the infinite graces that flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass which benefit one's soul, especially for the living. These graces provide all the more opportunity to save a soul that might otherwise be in peril of eternal loss. Pope Leo XIII in his encyclical "Mirae caritatis"—"Surprising Charity" 1902, beautifully elaborated this point and emphasized the connection between the communion of saints with the Mass: "The grace of mutual love among the living, strengthened and increased by the Sacrament of the Eucharist, flows, especially by virtue of the Sacrifice of the Mass, to all who belong to the communion of saints."

In his encyclical "Ecclesia de Eucharistia,"—"The Church and the Eucharist", our beloved late Holy Father, Pope Saint John Paul II, taught, "In the celebration of the Eucharistic Sacrifice, the Church prays that God, the Father of mercies, will grant His children the fullness of the Holy Spirit so that they may become one body and one spirit in Christ." (No. 43).

It is important to know also, that when a priest offers Holy Mass, he has three intentions: First, to offer the Mass reverently and validly in accord with the norms of the Church. Second, to offer the Mass in union with the whole Church and for the good of the whole Church. Third, to offer the Mass for a particular intention.

The special personal fruits of the Mass benefit the celebrating priest who acts in the person of Christ in offering the Mass and the people who are in attendance and participate in the offering of the Mass. These fruits are both extensively and intensively finite, since each of us is finite. The more a Mass is offered, the more benefit is conferred. St. Thérèse of Lisieux once asked Our Lord, "How can I thank thee for all the graces and blessings I have received from you?" Our Lord responded, "Attend one Mass!" St. John Marie Vianney once said: "If we really understood the Mass, we would die of joy!" St. John Chrysostom said: "When the Eucharist is being celebrated, the sanctuary is filled with countless angels who adore the Divine Victim immolated on the Altar."

Thus, when we ask to have a Mass offered, we are entering that intention into the fullness of the Divine Offering of the Son to the Father through the grace and virtues of the Holy Spirit. Additionally, the offering (stipend) given, has significance in and of itself also. First, it becomes apart of the Corporal Work of Mercy that we are offering, both in asking that the Mass be offered for an intention, but also in the giving from our bounty as a sign of our outward charitable action. Second, it provides for the Church's ability to exercise Corporal Works of Mercy by virtue of the donation you've made to and by extension, you therefore share in. Third, out of justice for the donation made, the stipend creates an obligation on behalf of the Church and the priest to honour that request which must be satisfied. Blessings, Fr. Tim
