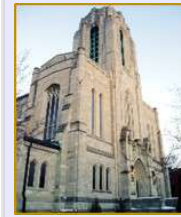

An excerpt from the Letter given to all Diocesan Parishes, by our newly appointed Auxiliary Bishop of Ottawa, Guy Desrochers, CSSR

Dear Pastors and Parish Administrators,
At Pastoral Day, a new Diocesan initiative was introduced — taking part in the *Flourishing Congregations Institute* research project; a national survey of Canadian congregations/parishes. It is a simple survey process but it will generate a comprehensive parish report which can help your parish identify its needs and ways to grow.

Details on this survey are as follows:

- This survey is free — parishes typically spend thousands of dollars for a survey like this.
- Any parish can be involved — parishes of any size and location, whether they see their parish as flourishing or not. **I ask that all parishes take part in this.**
- You will receive a free parish-specific report — a helpful catalyst for new or continued flourishing. The research team is hopeful that all leaders and adult parishioners in each parish involved take roughly 20 minutes to complete the online survey.
- You will have access to data-informed tools and resources — contribute to making the best and right resources available to Canadian parishes, based on Canadian data.

All parishes need to complete their surveys by the end of November. *Flourishing Congregations Institute* will produce your parish specific report and conclude their nation-wide research by the New Year.
