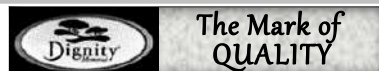

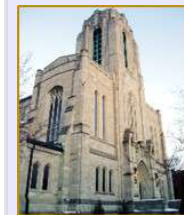

Bishop Christian Riesbeck, CC Appointed for the Diocese of Saint John, NB

The Most Reverend Christian Riesbeck, CC, currently Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Ottawa, has been appointed by the Holy See to the office of Bishop of the Diocese of Saint John, New Brunswick, effective December 9, 2019. Ordained to the priesthood on October 12, 1996 (Companions of the Cross), and installed as Auxiliary Bishop of Ottawa in 2014, his ministry has included pastoral assignments in Eastern Ontario and Houston, TX, and the office of Chancellor of the Archdiocese of Ottawa. Archbishop Terrence Prendergast said, "Today, I offer sincerest congratulations to Bishop Christian Riesbeck, CC on his appointment by Pope Francis as Bishop of Saint John. "The people of New Brunswick will come to know him as a dynamic pastor who encourages all to be missionary disciples, ready to share his episcopal motto *Evangelii Gaudium* — the 'joy of the gospel' — with others. "Since 2011, the Archdiocese of Ottawa has gleaned his wisdom as a canonist and been challenged by his energy as a pastor. I have personally profited from his advice as chancellor and been blessed by his service as my auxiliary bishop for five years. "I am sure the clergy, religious and lay faithful of Saint John will soon know and love this remarkable servant of Christ and his Church. "We will miss Bishop Christian. Our prayers and best wishes accompany him." The Diocese of Saint John, New Brunswick has 28 parishes, 68 churches and chapels, with a Catholic population of 115,400 served by 53 priests, two deacons, and 66 Sisters who are members of institutes of consecrated life. — *Archdiocese of Ottawa*

So... what happens now. Well, first off, once the appointment is announced, the new Bishop, if he is already ordained a Bishop, has 2 months in which to be installed into his new diocese. If the Bishop-Elect is not ordained a Bishop, he has three months within which to be ordained and then to be installed into his diocese. During the 2 or 3 month period, the Bishop-Elect will make visits to his new diocese to meet with the administrative team and begin the handover period. As one can imagine, this can be a very daunting process and can take a good year for a new Bishop to get a good understanding of what his Diocese is like. All in all, we celebrate with joy, this election by His Holiness, Pope Francis, of Bishop Riesbeck, CC as the new Ordinary of the diocese of Saint John, New Brunswick. FYI — the term ORDINARY refers to the Bishop who is the principle Shepherd of a diocese. This term reflects the canonical authority of "Ordinary Power", which means that the Bishop of the Diocese has the authority to exercise all of the powers given to the office of Bishop as the chief shepherd of a Diocese. Bishop Christian was an Auxiliary Bishop here in Ottawa, and so could only exercise those duties within the Diocese that were given to him by the Ordinary, Archbishop Prendergast, S.J.

Additionally, effective the time of his appointment, Bishop Christian, ceases to be the auxiliary of this Diocese and as such, his name is removed from the intervention within the Eucharistic Prayer when we pray for the Pope and for our Bishop(s).

May the Lord Bless him in his new ministry as Bishop Ordinary of the Diocese of Saint John, New Brunswick
