A New Home Found for Catechesis of the Good Shepherd at Blessed Sacrament Parish in the Ottawa Archdiocese!

Effective Fall 2018, the Fulton J. Sheen Room at Blessed Sacrament Parish will become a new home for *The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd*. The atrium at St. George's RC Parish will move from its current location into this beautiful space so that it may serve through a multi parish CGS model. Addressing the variety of needs and limitations of parishes, the atrium at Blessed Sacrament will offer an invitation to collaborate by sharing atrium space and materials, so that many more children from across the diocese will have the opportunity to fall in love with the Good Shepherd.

Currently there are six parishes offering CGS to over 150 children weekly in the diocese. The Blessed Sacrament atrium does not increase the number of atria, but does hope to improve access for families and maximize resources so that more children can (in the words of CGS parents) "experience Our Lord in a hands on, developmentally appropriate way and get closer to Him in a world where it is becoming easier to keep Him out of our lives."
