CONFIRMANDI MUST CHOOSE A SPONSOR. The guidelines to follow are:

- * There should be only one sponsor per candidate
- * Can NOT be the mother or father of the child, but a Godparent is a good choice (though not required)
- * Should be at least 16 years of age and must be mature enough to undertake this responsibility
- * Must have received the three sacraments of initiation, namely Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation
- * Must know the fundamental truths of the Faith and be a practicing Catholic
- * Must be a member of the Catholic Church in good standing

These requirements can be found in Canon 872, 873 and 874 of the Code of Canon Law for a valid and lawful sponsor. Parents of the Confirmation candidates will be provided with a Sponsor's Registration Form. Once a sponsor has been determined the registration form is to be completed and returned to the Parish office.

Beginning in January 2022, Confirmation Candidates must be actively involved in a Ministry at Blessed Sacrament Parish as part of their Sacramental Preparation. This involvement is an essential part of how we are called to be engaged in FULL, ACTIVE, CONSCIOUS PARTICIPATION in the practice of our Faith, especially when we come to Holy Mass.
